- The applicant must submit: (a) a current Utah State Contractor's License; (b) proof of comprehensive general liability insurance in an amount of not less than two million dollars (\$2,000,000.00) for any one occurrence and four million dollars (\$4,000,000.00) aggregate, and (c) a ten thousand dollar (\$10,000.00) performance bond owing to the City, that will be in effect for a period of two (2) years.
- The Public Works Representative/Engineer shall approve construction plans and cut sheets before any work begins.
- Prior to City issuing a permit, a traffic plan must be submitted by the permittee for review and approval by the Engineer.
- Asphalt shall be placed and tested as required by Chapter 4, Division 1-G of Springville City Standard Specifications.
- Arterial or collector street pavement surfaces must be replaced within three (3) calendar days of excavation or on the same day in which backfill is completed. All other streets must be resurfaced within seven (7) days.
- Contractor shall notify the Public Works Department two (2) working days in advance of work to be performed and also one (1) working day before any required inspection.
- Contractor shall guarantee work for two (2) years after the date of final inspection.
- Roads shall not be cut between October 15 and April 15 without permission from the Engineer, whether or not the permit has been issued.
- Prior to commencing work, the permittee is encouraged to secure video tape or photographs which positively identify the condition and existing damages to the public way improvements such as curbing, sidewalk, landscaping and asphalt surfaces, etc.
- Construction on arterial/major collector streets shall be discouraged during peak traffic hours of **7:00 to 9:00 am and 4:00 to 6:00 pm** unless authorized in writing by the Engineer.
- All provisions of the current *Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices* shall be adhered to.

I agree to comply with the above requirements, all applicable State and Federal Laws, all Springville City Standards, Specifications, Ordinances and other applicable requirements.
