Can I put rocks/concrete in my park strip?

Can I xeriscape my yard or am I required to have grass?

You can xeriscape your yard. The required landscaped areas, which are any portion of the required front or side yard adjacent to a street (corner side yard) that is not covered by structures, driveways or pedestrian paths. Instead of grass for the groundcover, drought tolerant type plants can be used that cover at least 75% of the required areas within 3-years.

Does the City plant trees in my park strip?

If it is contracted with the subdivision, yes. If you have further questions regarding street trees, please contact Parks at 801-489-2770.

What can I put in my park strip?
