Focus on... User Experience

"User experience" refers to a person's emotions and attitudes when they use a particular product or service. We work hard to make sure that we create an environment that allows for a positive experience even if our interaction with a patron is minimal. For example, we have clear signage, comfortable seating, a "holds" shelf near the front of the library, a drive through bookdrop, an easy to use website, and plenty of spaces to gather both inside and outside our library.

Additionally, we strive to surprise and delight those who come in the building with a rotation of interactive activities and displays. There is an imagination corner in the children's section, where kids can play on a stage with puppets and costumes, a great start to developing their literacy skills by becoming storytellers. The teen section has an expansive selection of board games, restaurant-style booths, and numerous computers, all of which help them to feel at home in their own section in the library.
