SPORTSMANSHIP POLICY

Springville City Parks & Recreation Department promotes sportsmanship, respect, integrity and fair play in all of its programs. We have an ongoing concern about keeping a high standard of sportsmanship in each of our sports. Players, spectators and recreation employees (officials, score keepers, commissioners) should be able to feel they are in a "safe" environment when they are participating, watching or working. We desire that all be aware of our "Sportsmanship Policy" before choosing to participate in the city's recreation programs.

Springville City Parks & Recreation has established the following "Sportsmanship Policy" for everyone involved in any of our programs. Everyone participating is expected to know, promote and adhere to the following policy and are subject to the following disciplinary actions based on a good/pass/poor assessment given by the officials or commissioners:

- <u>Good Assessment</u>- Positive, motivating and encouraging.
- Pass Assessment- No conflict.
- <u>Poor Assessment</u>- Technical fouls during games, disrespecting officials, provoking negative behavior, using profanity or degrading language/gestures.

If a team receives **3** or more poor assessments during the season, they will not be qualified to participate in the tournament. The Recreation department reserves the right to ban any parent/spectator/player/coach for repeated violations.

It is the goal of Springville City Parks and Recreation to uphold the integrity of each program it offers.
