

Springville Spring Clean-Up 2018

Friday, April 13th and Saturday, April 14th and Friday, April 20th and Saturday, April 21st have been designated as Spring Clean-Up days in Springville. Residents are encouraged to clean their yards, sweep gutters and sidewalks to improve yards and neighborhoods. Owners of vacant lots should clear their lots of garbage, tall weeds and debris. Scout groups, church groups, and other volunteer organizations are encouraged to plan service projects in their community.

Dumpsters are provided throughout the City on April 13th and 14th and April 20th and 21st at the following parks:

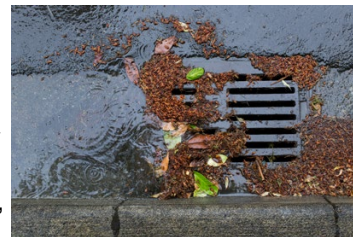

Spring Storm Water

Help keep our water CLEAN this Spring.

- Only apply pesticides and fertilizers in dry weather without a lot of wind. Try to apply insecticides during breeding months.
- Store pesticides, fertilizer and other garden chemicals inside or in covered segregated areas to prevent contaminated runoff.
- Use dry methods to clean up after a spill (rags or absorbents).
- Mix and load sprayers in an area where any spilled product will not be washed away into storm drains, ditches, creeks or ponds.
- Keep fertilizer off paved areas and sidewalks
- Read labels and use/dispose pesticides and fertilizers as directed.
- Do not over apply pesticides or fertilizers.
- Do not throw hazardous waste into the trash or into a storm drain.

Why does it matter? Polluted water that enters your storm drain (the grate in the street curb that collects water runoff) does not get treated, and instead flows directly into local water bodies where it can harm aquatic life and habitats, contaminate drinking water supplies and recreational waterways, and lesson aesthetic value. The Compost Facility is open to accept yard waste, located at 600 West 700 North, Tuesday – Saturday 8:00 am – 6:00 pm. Please bring proof of Springville residency. Disposal materials must be suitable to be ground for composting. All contaminants must be removed that would damage the grinding equipment.
