

Springville Arts Commission Minutes

Delora Bertelsen called the meeting to order at 7:10 P.M.

Present were Chuck Keeler, Robinne Booth, Delora Bertelsen, Glenn Alleman, Dawn Jensen, Milt Jones, Lou Ann Talcott, and Claudia Davenport. Donna Breckenridge was excused. Dawn Jensen gave the invocation.

Delora read a news article from the Springville Herald. A grant of \$6,600.00 from the Utah Department of Community and Culture has been given to make repairs on the Old Carnegie Library/D.U.P. Museum.

The minutes of the March meeting were read. Milt Jones made a motion to accept the minutes as amended. Claudia Davenport and Glenn Alleman seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Delora read a note from Vern Swanson thanking the Arts Commission for the grant of \$2,500.00 for conservation, \$500.00 for Community and Family Night at The Museum, and \$1000,00 for the Children's Arts Festival.

Teddy Anderson was released as a regular member of The Commission but will remain as an Ad Hoc member. Delora is looking for applicants to fill the position of Historian. Kolene Knight has been keeping newspaper clippings until a new Historian is found.

Chuck Keeler reported that the City Council recognizes The Villa Theater as high priority.

There will be a budget retreat April 24 and 25. Chuck will ask to double the \$4000,00 for statue clean up. Statues will need to be cleaned before they are placed in the new statue garden at City Hall.

They are hanging wallboard in the new City Hall building. Brick work will get under way as soon as we get nice weather.

The Summer Concert Series will begin with the Talent Festival at Art City Days. There will be 8 to 9 concerts in the series. A movie series has also been arranged.

Commission Reports

Historical Society: Glenn Alleman read an account of a murdered person found in Hobble Creek Canyon in the early days of Springville's history. The next Historical Society lecture will be held April 22 at the Springville Museum of Art.

Arts in Education: Donna was excused. Delora reported that all her grant money is out and she is getting reports on the projects now.

Graphic Arts and Museum: Dawn Jensen reported that the Spring Solon had 1,011 entries submitted. She invited everyone to attend the Art Ball on April 16. There will be dancing, viewing the Spring Solon, and the opening of the new statue garden. Delora asked if The Museum would consider having an Open House at Art City Days to show off the new garden.
