

Pipe Bursting Project

900 South between 800 East and 1500 East

The Pipe Bursting project is to replace aging sewer pipes along this route. Excavation will be at and around sewer man-holes in addition to where laterals are connected.

This will require all sewer laterals (from homes to street) along this roadway to be connected to the new sewer line. Residents will lose sewer capabilities for approximately a 12-hour period when their home is scheduled for the lateral attachments.

You will be able to use water, but toilets, sink drains, washers, etc., should not be used. Please avoid water going down the drains.

The time for the sewer system to be shut off is from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. There will be approximately four homes at a time shut off during this time period. The pipe bursting construction will begin on Tuesday, September 9 and should conclude by October 31.

You should receive fliers of notification on your home 48-hours in advance of your lateral hook-ups taking place. These will be distributed by Condie Construction Company of Springville.

Setting up the construction sites and traffic controls is planned to begin on Tuesday, September 2.
