COMMITTEE BUSINESS

Liability – Karrie Beardall / Chief Clinton

Chief Hank Clinton talked briefly about the Utah State CERT Conference. The pressing topic at the conference seemed to be liability. Karrie Beardall read the Utah Good Samaritan law, Utah Code 78B-4-501, which holds persons free from suit as long as they are acting within the scope of their training and are trying to assist. They also said that they checked with the City Manager and he advised that once a CERT member signs in at a disaster site they are then covered under the city's Workman's Comp Insurance for any injury incurred while assisting in the disaster.

The Chief said that CERT sector maps were emailed to everyone and he also has hard copies available if needed.

Spot light - "Kolob Sector"

The spotlight was on the Kolob Stake, Jeff Stinson spoke. He said last year they had a block captain dry run and did fairly well, it was good practice. This year they are trying to get more involved in getting more equipment. It is in the planning stages and he wants to push annual

meetings with the block captains. Martin said that he went to a ward preparedness fair in the Kolob Stake and they had good information and a great breakfast.

Chapter "9" – Chief Clinton

Chief Clinton went through an outline of Chapter 9 of the City Emergency Operations Plan. There are hard copies available if you need them. He also gave out a handout on the responsibilities of the Stake Presidents and other team members. See attached handout.

Drill prep – Comments

Chief Clinton said that he, Karrie Beardall and Martin Palmer are the main planning committee for the drill scheduled in August. They will recruit some other key people as the planning progresses and involve the committee. They have figured out that if everyone currently involved participates we could have 900 people working in the drill.
