Assignments:

DeEtte – Put gala on hold city was slow to approve the sale of the signs

Chris wanted to repaint the signs – Craig told him not to touch them at this time.

Need \$3,600 from the signs

- Bidding will begin Wednesday 2nd of December end the 12th of December
- The word will be spread via email and Facebook
- If we are to the end and the signs are not sold we will open it up to the entire database
- If we don't sell them then we try to leverage them other ways
- Any more ideas email to each other
- DeEtte will email out the information and spearhead the emails

Jay will need a check by March for the new signs – Craig Warren said he would donate as well to help with the signs.
