Minutes of the meeting held on June 23, 2016
Community Services Building – 443 S 200 E– 6:30 p.m.

CALL TO ORDER: Meeting called to order by Gary Hooper at 6:38 p.m.

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES: Lynn Bartholomew made a motion to approve minutes of the meeting held on May 26, 2016. Kristin Valdez seconded the motion. Vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

RECREATION UPDATE: Corey Merideth said they are winding down with the baseball/softball leagues and tournaments are coming up. Soccer will be next.

ART CITY DAYS: Corey reported a good turnout for all of the events. Friday night movie at Bartholomew Park had 80-100 people in attendance. We will be moving teen game night to Tuesday night. Not having concert Friday night saved close to \$40,000. We had the best revenue ever from the carnival. The Grand Parade was very well attended. Volleyball tournament didn't take place due to lack of participation. Duct tape regatta had 30 teams. Everything ran very smoothly and the members of the Youth City Council were awesome. Hot air balloons never launched because of wind.

AQUATICS CENTER: Alex Roylance presented the design plans for the aquatics and activity center. Proposed design plans include two big slides, basketball standards on ends of leisure pool, lazy river and kiddie pool. Leisure pool could be used for lap swimming, water aerobics, swim lessons, etc. This facility will be built to last 35-40 years. Exterior will have some block, glass, translucent panels and metal panels. We are trying to get as much natural light as possible without overheating problems. Katie Sosa and Kristin Valdez suggested fun things for kids to climb on, spray features and water buckets. We plan on construction starting next month. Alex wants feedback from board on what features are wanted. Do we want a theme for the kiddie area?

PARKS UPDATE: Alex met at the community park with CUWCD. Their planned date to begin is August with completion in October.

Design firm for the next phase of the Wayne Bartholomew Family Park is MGB+A. This is the same group that designed the Civic Center Splash Pad. New trail has been installed at Bartholomew Park, plus more asphalt patching at entrance of park. Concessions stand is open daily (except Sundays) from 11:00 a.m. to 7 p.m. We will be planting more trees to create sound barrier for neighbors, plus adding playgrounds and grass to disperse people throughout the park.

Evergreen Cemetery office and restrooms are being remodeled.
