MICRO LESSON – presented by Martin Palmer

KITCHEN FIRES:

Stove Fire – (Turn off heat; Cold rag with water; smother fire with cloth- DO NOT POUR WATER ON THE FIRE);

approach the fire with the lid held at an angle; cover with lid; turn off heat source; move pan off burner

Microwave Fire – Don't put metal or foil in the microwave; if a fire starts in the microwave, leave the door closed; unplug the microwave and let it burn out;

Use Type K fire extinguishers in the kitchen (nontoxic gas/powder)

Be sure to change smoke detector batteries every 6 months; Leave the batteries inside; press test button

Replace smoke and CO2 detectors every 10 years
