All families assigned to put up green markers; ward reps is asking specific families to post red markers, instead. MAKE SURE EACH HOUSE HAS ITS OWN SET OF RED/GREEN/YELLOW MARKERS.

Disaster drill participants should show up by 8:30 am ("victims" arrive at 8 am); stakes should receive all reports by 9am; mock mass casualty will start about 9:15am and lasts about an hour; Entire drill will be over by 11 a.m.
