CALL TO ORDER

Meeting was called to order by Patrick Monney at 5:30 p.m.

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES

No previous minutes have been recorded. This group has been less formal since this is a committee for basic organization of the event and not a Board with officially appointed members.

PUBLIC COMMENT

No outside public members were in attendance.

COMMITTEE BUSINESS

Patrick was recently elected to City Council, and up to this point Patrick and Heidi have been co-chairs for the committee. It was agreed that Patrick is now the Council representative and Heidi Monney will become the Committee Chair.

FLOAT: Megan reported that the Grand Parade float is being constructed. Springville High school students are building the metal base, and there will be 3 art concept designs to choose between. Utah Virtual Academy is also making an opportunity for local students to contribute. Students may do the actual decorating and there will be a lot more local involvement that previously.

DIGNITARIES: Several names were suggested as nominees for Parade Grand Marshal and Resident Artist. The committee settled on Jim and Shirlene Jordan for 2020 Grand Marshal. Sculptor Bryan Draper was chosen for 2020 Resident Artist at the suggestion of Emily.

CONCERT & FIREWORKS: Craig has been working to complete an agreement with the group “Simply Queen” as the entertainment for the concert. The fireworks show is lined up and the soundtrack is in the works.

BALLOON FEST: Sandy will no longer be helping so she is training Shelena. The location at Cherry Creek Elementary has not been good since it’s closer to the canyon and unpredictable morning wind

prevents the balloons from taking off safely. Art City Elementary would be better, but Corey mentioned an underground water line that cannot have trucks or equipment driving over it. Corey will check. Also discussed was a possible “balloon glow” on Thursday evening to promote the Friday and Saturday morning events. The location of Meadow Brook school was presented as a possibility because of additional parking available at the CRC and the adjacent church building.

VENDORS: Megan has received information from Shaun and is getting the application form updated to be posted on the ACD website.

RODEO: Kami is happy to report that there is already a contract in place, which should make organizing the event a lot easier this year. The contract also has an option to extend. She mentioned the possibility of online entries for contestants this year, so she will connect with Jodi and set something up on the existing Rec1 registration system that is used for youth sports.

ACTION ITEM:

- Corey will be meeting to finalize the interlocal agreement with Nebo School District and will discuss using Art City Elementary and Meadow Brook Elementary for some of the Art City Days events.

Next meeting is scheduled for February 10, 2020.
