

CANVASS REPORT

2015 Municipal General Election Springville City, Utah

The Springville City 2015 General Election was conducted on November 3, 2015, using electronic voting machines in conjunction with Utah County. A general election was held for three City Council seats each for a term of four years.

There were 13924 active registered voters within Springville City with 5698 ballots cast for a voter turnout of 40.92%

Richard J. Child received 3809 votes with 30.35% of votes cast.

Christopher K. Creer received 3451 votes with 27.50% of votes cast.

Jason Miller received 3320 votes with 26.45% of votes cast.

Robert J. Anderson received 1971 votes with 15.70% of votes cast.

There were 315 provisional ballots collected by Utah County. There were no disqualified ballots reported. Provisional ballots are disqualified if they did not have proof of residency, were not registered voters, or had already voted.

A total of 571 absentee ballots were collected by Utah County and 1006 Early Voting ballots cast.

There were 5611 ballots cast for the Springville Bond Proposition.

FOR the Bond Proposition 3373 votes were received with 60.11% of votes cast

AGAINST the Bond Proposition 2238 votes received with 39.89% votes cast

Individual results of the election can be found in Resolution #2015-19 and Resolution #2015-21. Candidates elected for office to serve terms of four years, beginning January 4, 2016, are as follows:

WHEREAS, an election was held on November 03, 2015 to fill positions on the City Council with terms that expire on the first Monday of January, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the election was duly and regularly held, and the election results have been officially canvassed by this City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Springville City, Utah, acting as the Board of Canvassers, as follows:

Section 1. It is hereby officially found, determined and declared that 3809 votes were cast in favor of Richard J. Child; 3451 votes were cast in favor of Christopher K. Creer; 3320 votes were cast in favor of Jason Miller; and 1971 votes were cast in favor of Robert J. Anderson.



Section 4. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.






After the meeting had been duly called to order and after other matters not pertinent to this resolution had been discussed, the City Recorder presented to the Council a Certificate of Compliance With Open Meeting Law with respect to this November 17, 2015 meeting, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

It was then moved by Councilmember Conover, seconded by Councilmember Creer, and carried unanimously that the Council sit as a Board of Canvassers for the purpose of canvassing the returns of the special bond election held in the City on November 3, 2015.

The Council thereupon made a proper canvass of the election returns of said special election in accordance with Sections 11-14-207, 20A-4-301(3), 20A-4-302 and 20A-4-303, Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended, including making publicly available at the meeting the return of voting for each precinct, and at conclusion of the canvass made the following official findings:

PROPOSITION

Shall the City Council of Springville City, Utah (the "City"), be authorized to issue General Obligation Bonds in an amount not to exceed Eleven Million One Hundred Ninety-Five Thousand Dollars (\$11,195,000) (the "Bonds") for the purpose of paying all or a portion of the costs of constructing and furnishing of a new aquatics and activities center and all related improvements, and for payment of expenses reasonably incurred with the construction of said facilities (the "Project") and the authorization and issuance of the Bonds; said Bonds to be due and payable in not to exceed twenty-one (21) years from the date of issuance of the Bonds?

Property Tax Cost of Bonds. If the Bonds are issued as planned, an annual property tax to pay debt service on the Bonds will be required over a period of twenty (20) years in the estimated amount of \$60.52 per year (approximately \$5.04 per month) on a \$207,695 (average home value in Springville) primary residence and in the estimated amount of \$110.04 per year on a business property having the same value.

The foregoing information is only an estimate (based upon current taxable values without consideration of any increase/decrease of the same over the twenty (20) year period) and is not a limit on the amount of taxes that the City may be required to levy in order to pay debt service on the Bonds. The City is obligated to levy taxes to the extent provided by law in order to pay the Bonds.


