A RESOLUTION TO RE-APPLY WITH THE STATE TO CONTINUE A RECYCLING MARKET DEVELOPOMENT ZONE (RMDZ) AND EXTEND A 20% DISCOUNT ON BUSINESS LICENSE FEES FOR BUSINESSES WITHIN THE ZONE WHO PARTICIPATE IN THE PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, Springville City is re-applying to continue the RMDZ program for businesses located within the Springville Industrial Park;

WHEREAS, Springville City currently has a business who participates in the RMDZ program;

WHEREAS, the business has expressed interest in continued participation with the RMDZ program; and

WHEREAS, Springville City desires to continue its show of support for the RMDZ program and offers a 20% discount on annual business license fees issued by the City to businesses located within the zone and now participate in the RMDZ program.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Springville City Council as follows:


